

ABSTRACT

The study was conducted for three objectives as follows : 1) to find out the actual quality of life and satisfaction of the Quality of Life of Warrant Officers of the 3rd Cavalry Squadron Warrant Officers of the 3rd Cavalry Squadron 2) to examine the factors affecting their quality of life, and 3) to identify their needs for social welfare.

Copies of a questionnaire were distributed to 279 non-commissioned army officers under Warrant Officers of the 3rd Cavalry Squadron and 230 copies were returned. The findings were summarized as follows :

1. The overall quality of life of the non-commissioned army officers were found to be moderate.

2. The variables found to have no significant relationship with their quality of life were age, number of working years, rank, marital status, number of household members, and work incentives. Only education was found to be significantly related to their quality of life.

3. The Warrant Officers of the 3rd Cavalry Squadron and higher-level agencies should ask heads of different work units to study the quality of life of their subordinates and set a plan to improve their quality of life.
