## **ABSTRACT**

The study served the following objectives:

to reveal the attitude of the chief administrators of the Tambol
 Administration Organizations toward the Tambol Administration Organization council election,

- 2. to identify the factors related to their attitude toward this matter, and
- 3. to use the research results to determine an appropriate guideline to solve the election administration problem.

The population of the survey were 6,746 chief administrators of Tambol Administration Organizations who used to deal with the election of Tambol Administration Organizations council members. The data were collected by mailing a questionnaire to them and they were asked to return the questionnaires by mail, too. The total of 358 questionnaires were returned.

The findings were briefly stated below:

1. Most of the chief administrators of the Tambol Administration
Organizations were males, aged more than 30. They were married and had a
Bachelor's degree. Their household income was in the range of 10,001-20,000 band
per month. They had never received any training on the administration of the election
of the Tambol Administration Organizations council members. They were members of
the Chief Administrators of the Tambol Administration Organization Club. They
accessed to related information about the election at a high level and had a moderate
knowledge about the election administration.

- Their attitude toward the administration of the Tambol Administration
   Organizations council members election was found to be moderate.
- 3. The factors found to be significantly related to their attitude were membership of the Club of Chief Administrators of the Tambol Administration Organization and the knowledge about the election administration.
