

## ABSTRACT

**Title of Research Paper** : Attitudes of the Government Officers at the Government House toward Recognition on the People's Protest around the Government House in 2000

The research paper had two following objectives :

1. to study the attitudes of the Government Officers at the Government House toward recognition on the people's protest around the Government House in 2000.
2. to study the facts affecting with the attitudes of the Government Officers at the Government House toward recognition on the people's protest around the Government House in 2000.

The Sample Groups were 272 Government Officers at the Government House. The data was collected by using questionnaires with the returning of 272 questionnaires (100%). The data was analyzed by using statistics including percentage, mean, standard deviation, t - test and F - test.

**Result**

1. In overall, most of the Government Officers at the Government House were female (70.6%), age 30 - 39 (44.9%), completed bachelor degree (64.3%), and workage 10 years and under (43.0%)
2. Attitudes of the Government Officers at the Government House toward recognition on the people's protest around the Government House in 2000 were at a moderate level. When ranking from high to low respectively, they were a recognition on the government resolution, recognition on the people's protest, and recognition on the government officers' difficulties.
3. The facts affecting with the attitudes of the Government Officers at the Government House toward recognition on the people's protest were education level,

workage, and constitutional and political knowledge. On the contrary, department description, democratic knowledge, and political activities participation had no significant relationship with attitudes of the Government Officers at the Government House toward recognition on the people's protest.
