The study of "Working Efficiency of Village Poverty Alleviation Project Committee" had following objectives:

1. to study working efficiency of Village Poverty Alleviation Project committee,

2. to study factors affecting working efficiency of Village Poverty Alleviation Project committee by setting 11 factors which were sex, age, position, marital status, education level, living period in the village, working period, family income, training experience, attitude towards Village Poverty Alleviation Project and knowledge and understanding in their roles.

The data were collected by using questionnaires. The sample group consisted of 160 committees of Village Poverty Alleviation Project from 18 villages in Nong Chilk District, Pattani Province.

Results

1. Working efficiency of Village Poverty Alleviation committee was at a

moderate to high level which meant that the performance of this project in Nong chilk District was successful and achieve the objectives.

2. Factors affecting working efficiency of Village Poverty Alleviation Project committee were living period in the village, family income, training experience, attitude towards Village Poverty Alleviation Project and knowledge and understanding in their roles. However, factors which had no relationship with working efficiency of Village Poverty Alleviation Project committee were sex, age, position, marital status, education level and working period.

3. The problems and obstacles of this project were: 1) members of the project could not return their money when it was due, 2) committee of the project wanted to receive some compensation, 3) budget of the project was less than members need and 4) members did not follow the objectives of the project.
