

ABSTRACT

The main objectives of this research are to study the coordination work of the Project 100 year Bangkla and to find out problems and obstacles to the coordination work of the committee organizing the project and involved agencies.

The methods of study are both documentary and field research by interviewing 12 key-informants from concerned agencies and the organizing committee in-depth; data collected were later analysed by logical context description plus descriptive statistics of percentage and mean.

Results of the study reveal that the forms of external coordination applied by the organizing committee and concerned agencies are along the workplan and agreement set forth before, both in working system and in personal relation. As for the internal coordination, the vertical type of coordination, both formally and informally, was applied.

One of the most important problems in coordination is the persons involved, i.e., conflicting in approaches because of differences in target and work patterns; there is also a structural problem in work system, in complexity of line of the command. In addition, lack of knowledge, lack of positive attitude toward work / organization, lack of information and budget all are problems and obstacles for good coordination.

Important recommendations emerged from this study, among others, are, in organizing another activities, long-term coordination should be established continually. External coordination should be based on mutual understanding with the cognizance of

being different; applying knowledge gained from previous coordination to the next, and so on.
