

Kanchana Srilanuruk 2014: Police College Image. Master of Arts (Political Science),
Major Field: Political Science, Department of Political Science and Public Administration.

The objectives of the study were to investigate the Police College image, compare the Police College image classify by personal factor, reception and information of the Police College to and study the relationship of the Police College image and the knowledge of rules and functions of the Police College. The 121 polices with police captain in training course of 132th police inspector, Police College was the sample of the study. The questionnaire was the instrument for collecting data. The percentage, mean, standard deviation, t-Test, one way ANOVA and Pearson Product-Moment Correlation Coefficient were the statistical analysis.

The result of the study found that the respondent was much agreed to Police College image. The sample were most agree in personal image, the rest was the procedure image. The sample were least agree in office equipment. The respondent received the information of the Police College at moderate level, the most was internet and the least was the radio. Moreover, the respondent understood the role the Police College at much level. The comparison of the opinion toward Police College image classifying by personal factors and level of information receiving found that age, sex, education, position and organization were not differed image of Police College image which was not accepted the hypothesis. The receiving information factors concerning was differed to image of the Police College which accepted the hypothesis. There was no relation between the understanding in the role and duty of the Police College image and the image of Police College was not accepted the hypothesis.
