

Risakul Tippawan 2014 : Factors Affecting the Management of the Village and Urban Community Funds,Pakkret Municipality, Nonthaburi Province. The objectives of this research objective were to study 1) the level of success in management of the funds project in Village and Urban Community Pakkret Municipality, Nonthaburi Province 2) to compare the opinions on the factors affecting the success of the Village funds management project based on personal factors and 3) to find out the relationship between the knowledge about the Village Funds project and factors affecting the Village Funds management. The samples research consisted of 390 committee and members of Pakkret Ruam Jai 2 and Bang Pood Sa Makkee 4 Village funds project. Data were gathered by using questionnaire and analyzed by using computer program.The statistics used in data analyzes were percent, mean, standard deviation, t-test, F-test, the Pearson correlation coefficient and determine the statistical significance level of 0.05.

The results showed that 1) the level of success in management of the funds project in Village and Urban Community was at high level 2) the and member of village funds project holding different gender had different opinions on the success of the village and urban Community management with statistical significance level of 0.05, on the other hand the member of village funds project with different age, occupation, education, incomes, duration of membership and length of residence in an area had no different opinions in the success of Village and Urban Community management with statistical significance level of 0.05 3) Members knowledgeable about the village and urban communities was high . And overall knowledge of the Funds, Housing and Urban Community was correlated positively with the factors for the success of the Housing and Urban Management, at statistically significant level of 0.05.
