

ABSTRACT

This research study in title of "Islamic Non-governmental Organizations (NGOs) Management : Cases Study of NGOs in Bangkok Metropolitan" has objectives as followings. (1) To study roles, reason in organization establishment and evolution of islamic NGOs from the past until the present and trends in the future. (2) To study internal administration in islamic NGOs. (3) To study their problems and obstructions in managing islamic NGOs. This research chose 3 NGOs from more than 100 NGOs in Bangkok Metropolitan to be case studies in research. And beyond the method of studying from document (Documentary Research), the data is also collected from interviewing employees working in these organizations, especially the authorized management which have decision authority in each organization such as Santichon Foundation, Thai Muslim Women Foundation of Thailand for the Welfare of Orphans under the Royal Patronage of His Majesty the King and Kamalulislam Mosque.

These studies find that their organization origins and establishment relate to their present activities. All of them have concept in founding for religious purposes. And all of them have activities in religious communication and education. Their organizations are managed by committee; otherwise, their operations still depend on their leaders in financial management. Most of their money is from donations which depend on abilities and aptitudes of each organization in fund raising locally or abroad. For some organizations, all of the money is administered to be saved in banks for collecting interest. Moreover every organization has accounting management to send reports to government offices. For personnel management, there are two types of employees

as full time and voluntary staff. Obstructions found in their operations are capital shortage, personal shortage, small limitation of place to operate activities, etc.

Furthermore we find that every organization has strong will to continue its operations further in the future. Except in the case of Thai Muslim Women Foundation of Thailand for the Welfare of Orphans under the Royal Patronage of His Majesty the King, which needs a new management to take charge from the present administrators.
