

Sirilak Payapmek 2014: Factor Influencing the Performance of Registered Nurse at Siriraj Hospital. Master of Education (Vocational Education Development), Major Field: Vocational Education Development, Department of Vocational Education. Thesis Advisor: Associate Professor Surachai Jewcharoensakul, Ph.D. 109 pages.

The present study aimed at determining the awareness level and the factors Influencing the awareness of nursing performance, cooperative performance, career commitment, and knowledge management in predict the performance of registered nurse at Siriraj hospital. The study was assessed among a stratified random sample of 346 registered nurses, working in the Inpatient Department (IPD) at Siriraj hospital, using structured questionnaires. Data collected were analyzed using by descriptive statistics (e.g. percentage, mean, and standard deviation) and stepwise multiple regression analysis.

Results revealed that the awareness level of nursing performance reaching the highest level whereas those of cooperative performance, career commitment and knowledge management at high level. Additionally, the Factors awareness of nursing performance, cooperative performance, career commitment, and knowledge management could predict a total of 48.10 percent of variance on the performance of registered nurse at Siriraj hospital at the significance level at 0.01.
