

Sureerat Pimkate 2014: Development of Creative Writing Skills on Thai Language for Grade 4 Primary Students. Master of Education (Curriculum and Instruction), Major Field: Curriculum and Instruction, Department of Education.

The objectives of this study were to develop and evaluate the quality of creative writing skills on Thai language for grade 4 primary students. This was the research and development research. The samples used in this study was 10 experts in Thai language and curriculum and instruction by purposive sampling. Research instruments included the table of the creative writing skills analysis on Thai language for Grade 4 primary students and evaluation of creative writing skills on Thai language practice. Statistics used for data analysis were percentage, mean, standard deviation, and content analysis.

The research findings were as follows: 1) The results of the practice analysis table were the table of ten creative writing skills topics for grade 4 primary students. 2) The results of the development of creative writing skills on Thai language were the practice of ten creative writing topics on Thai language for grade 4 primary students. Each topic included 5 practices of creative writing; Fluency Thinking, Flexible Thinking, Elaborative Thinking, Originality Thinking and overall conception of these 4 thinkings. 3) The quality of 10 practice topics are in the highest level and can be used as the instructional materials to develop the creative writing Skills.
