### **Details of Each TCC Activity in 2006**

In this section, it provides details in each TCC activity based on Toyota Co-operation Club Annual Book 2007.

#### **Safety Activity**

It was organized in order to strengthen the control of safety in operations at plants for all TCC members through Completed Checked Completely Find out (CCCCF) activity. The concept of CCCC is to find out what kind of accidents mostly occur in work place and how they should be prevented. In 2006, there were only five companies that passed TCC criteria.
