

Rattana Sangbuaphuen 2013: Development of Academic Management System Model for Basic Education of the Office of Basic Education Commission. Doctor of Philosophy (Curriculum and Instruction), Major Field: Curriculum and Instruction, Department of Education. Thesis Advisor: Associate Professor Nataya Pilanthanonond, Ph.D. 400 pages.

The purpose of this research was to develop of academic management system model for Basic Education of the Office of Basic Education Commission conducted by a three-stage procedure: 1) Synthesis of academic management system model in the United States of America, New Zealand, Australia, England and Singapore, 2) The study of experts' opinions, and 3) An appropriate model of academic management system improvement for Basic Education of the Office of Basic Education Commission. The sample was twenty five high ranking executives and academic officials of the Office of Basic Education Commission, directors and the heads of supervisors of the Education Service Area Offices by using purposive sampling. The instrument in this research was the questionnaire about appropriate model.

The results of the research showed that the model of the Office of Basic Education Commission of Thailand and the foreign academic management system models were similar, but scopes of job description were different. The researcher designed new model by considering about working process, reducibility repetition of work, and learner qualities. The experts rank the highest points to new model. The propose model the Office of Basic Education Commission should be studied and prepared for avoiding problems.
