

Benjawan Danpradit 2014: Self-regulation, Adversity Quotient,
Intrinsic Motivation and Academic Success of Sophomores at Kasetsart
University, Bang Khen Campus. Master of Science (Community Psychology),
Major Field: Community Psychology, Department of Psychology.

The purposes of this research were 1) to study the level of self-regulation, adversity quotient, intrinsic motivation of sophomores at Kasetsart University, Bang Khen campus. 2) to investigate academic success by personal factors 3) to study correlation between self-regulation, adversity quotient, intrinsic motivation and academic success of sophomores at Kasetsart University, Bang Khen campus. Samples were 379 sophomores which were selected by stratified random sampling. The research tools were questionnaires and analyzed by using computer package program. The statistical procedures were percentage, mean, standard deviation, t-test, F-test, multiple comparisons (LSD), Pearson's product moment correlation coefficient.

The results of the study were as follow; 1) level of self-regulation, adversity quotient and academic success were high but intrinsic motivation was moderate. Sophomores who had difference in mother's occupation had difference in academic success which was statistical significant at .05. Self-regulation, adversity quotient and intrinsic motivation showed positive correlations with academic success significantly at .000.
