The purpose of this study was to appraise the ability of subdistrict health personnel in Nakornsritammaraj province and the correlation between demographics, performance and satisfaction with the ability to prevent and control non-communicable diseases. The population of this study consisted of 246 subdistrict health personnel members who prevent and control the non-communicable diseases in Nakornsritammaraj province. The methods used in analyzing data were Chi-square test and Pearson's Product Moment Correlation Coefficient.

The results showed that the ability of subdistrict health personnel to prevent and control the non-communicable diseases was ranked at a medium level. The satisfaction in working, such as achievement, recognition, work itself, responsibility, advancement, policy and administration, supervision of techniques and relationships at the work place, correlated with the effectiveness of the ability in prevention and control of non-communicable diseases. The researcher suggested that there should be a session on acquiring more knowledge on prevention and control of non-communicable diseases. Moreover ,the administrator should give more moral support to the subdistrict public health personnel.
