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RAMPAI KAEVVICHIEEN : THE ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION
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The purpose of this research was to develop an environmental training curriculum for subdistrict health staff working on klong conservation in subdistrict health centers, Ministry of Public Health civil officials and Subdistrict Administrative Organization, Ministry of Interior civil officials. The procedure was divided into 5 steps. The first was the training needs assessment, including study of the organization policies and plan as well as needs Survey was conducted using structured interviews. Second was setting curriculum goals and objectives, including choosing curriculum structure, environmental education concept and behavior objectives. Third was curriculum development, consisting of contents, training techniques and administration. Fourth was using a 2 day training program to train 29 officials . Fifth was curriculum evaluation, studying trainees' knowledge and attitude to evaluate curriculum efficiency by comparing knowledge and attitude before and after training. Trainees' observers' and instructors' opinions about the training were also evaluated .

The result showed that the trainees' knowledge and attitude toward klong conservation increased significantly at the level 0.05. Most of the trainees, observers and instructors felt that training organization was good.
