The process of home health care is important and an efficient administration process for home health care it is essential. This study aims to analyze the process of Administration home health care in the Public Health Office in Angthong. The study uses POSDCORB theory, collects data, interviews the health board and use questionnaires for health officers. Data was collected From August 9 to August 27, 1999. Analysis was by percentage of descriptive statistics, mean and standard deviation. The results show that the administration process and analysis of home health care in the Public Health Office in Angthong Province is fairly good (70.4 %). Planning, organizing, directing and reporting are fairly good (56.13%), should be improved (21.4%) staffing, co-ordination and budgeting clear responsibility for home health care needs to be identified. Co-ordination is not good enough for continuing care and health officers are not well trained their jobs (42.86%). There is not enough time to plan use of the budget because it is too late to get it (24.48%). The province committee does not supervise or follow up on the Home Health Care program.

This study suggests the importance of having an organization responsible for home health care. It should be able to co-ordinate between each department. Health officers should be well trained and continually prepared for their jobs home health care budgeting should be efficient. Supervisory follow up should be continued in order to reach the goal of an effective administration process for analysis of home health care.
