The main objective of this research was to study the awareness of crime prevention of the factory owners in Nakornpathom Province. Key informants comprised of 328 persons of factory owners and workers in the factory located in Nakornpathom province. The instruments used to gather data for this study were questionnaires (checklist) and rank ratio which divided into 4 phases namely: Phase 1 - data related to social behavioural of key informants, Phase 2 - experiences related to crime, Phase 3 - the awareness of crime prevention of the factory owners in Nakornpathom province. Data analysis used in phase 1 to 3 were in the form of descriptive, percentage, means and variation. Phase 4 - factors related to the awareness of crime prevention of the factory owners in Nakornpathom province were analysed by One-way Analysis of Variance and t-test

The information obtained from the study indicated that, by overall image, there happened to be much of the awareness of crime prevention of which such awareness was entitled to be ready prior to the crime occurrence much more than after the crime occurrence. Factors related to the awareness of crime prevention of the factory owners in Nakornpathom province were gender and marital status, which was statistically significant difference at .05 level.

Recommendations:

- 1. Factory owners should enhance crime prevention by installing the Safety System.
- Factory owners and workers should enhance the awareness of crime prevention by disseminating details of the suspected to the policemen.
- 3. Factory owners should arrange training course and seminar regarding crime prevention to the workers and other involved people continually and regularly.
