The objective of this survey research was to evaluate the sub-district health planning process in Pichit province. The survey results were completed by 107 key informant representatives, one from each of the health centers, during March 1999 and statistically analysed by using frequency, percentage, average, standard deviation and multiple logistic regression.

The findings were that the sub-district health planning process in Pichit province was evaluated to be at high level . However, the planning stage and the implementation stage still have weaknesses that need correction. These underlying factors were thought require improvement not only in the academic knowledge but also the share-value promotion, all which were needed to develop basic skills-planning, analyzing and evaluating of the health center officers.

Variables statistically significantly ($p < 0.05$) associated, with the sub-district health planning process achievement included highest level of education, job experience, training opportunities, age, health planning, data analyzing, perceptive role, and health center development, satisfaction, achievement, recognition, and work itself .

The curriculum approach to the organization development especially to the health planning, should have to be provided continuously in order to strengthen all levels of district health officers skills and shared-value.
