## Abstract

The thesis entitled "The directions of the development of the rehabilitation services for the disabled in the next decade (B.E. 2549-2558) a case study of the Social Development and Welfare Department with the Ethnographic Delphi Future Research (EDFR) technique" has employed the future research form with EDFR technique with seventeen specialists who have been working or have experiences related to the disabled in various fields. Recommendations from the study The Rehabilitation Center for the disabled should be developed to become an international rehabilitation center for the disabled, improve the budget system with focus on the result, prepare the master plan on the profession and improvement on the new curriculum, arrange an efficient monitoring and assessment system, promote the professional and local cooperation network, as well as mental training for the disabled for ethics, morals and social responsibility.
