The purposes of this study were to investigate the satisfaction and factors associated with satisfaction of the Klong Toey slum dwellers on the operation of the narcotic prevention and suppression plan of Tharua police. The data were collected by using a questionnaire with 400 dwellers in Klong Toey slum.

The research results revealed that :

1. The Klong Toey slum dwellers were satisfied on the operation of the narcotic prevention and suppression plan of Tharua police at a moderate level.
2. Factors associated with the satisfaction of the Klong Toey slum were benefits previously obtained from the operation of the police, attitude towards the police officers, the feeling of insecurity and threat from narcotic, acknowledgment of narcotic prevention information from various media.

From the research results, it was recommended that the government and authorities related to the narcotic prevention and suppression, especially the Royal Thai Police, should increase their role or establish a tangible and clear policy to create more benefits from and better image of the narcotic prevention operation and narcotic prevention officials. Community relations improvement efforts should be made. More measures should be planned and improvement to suppress narcotic and arrest offenders. A public relations campaign, through television media, should be undertaken to promote narcotic prevention in the general public. This should affect the public's satisfaction with the narcotic prevention and suppression effects of the Tharua police.
