The main objective of this research focuses on studying and identifying the readiness in police's enforcement of mobile patrol unit in Patrol and Special Operation Division, in 5 parts:

- 1. the readiness of general knowledge and ability
- 2. the readiness of mentality
- 3. the readiness of materials and instrument
- 4. the readiness about the family.
- 5. the readiness about the responsibility

Data were collected from 224 subjects using questionnaires, and were analyzed using SPSS for Windows software.

The result of the research shows:

- (1) Police in mobile patrol unit in Patrol and Special Operation Division have readiness to work at middle level.
- (2) The individual differences especially in financial and social background influence readiness to work.

The researcher recommends that implementation should be undertaken on providing more basic knowledge about working. More support should be given in terms of equipment.

Officers should also have more welfare support.
