The Purposes of the finding are : 1)To study the trade developments and its schemes along the borderline of the so called gateway to Indochina. 2)To study the problems and obstacles related to trading activities along the gateway to Indochina's borders and their affects on local communities. 3)To gain insight on social and economic situations local ways of living so as trading value along the border. For the samples of population these comprised of stakeholders e.g.custom officials provincial trade representative provincial revenue office provincial chamber of commerce and related agencies. In addition 350 locals were randomly and specifically and quality aspects.

Conducted in-depth interviews aspects dialogues engagement and performed non-participative observations. According to the result of the study import and export along the border had direct impaction on the continuing development and growth of Thailand's economy. The result also indicated that trading activities mainly came from small and medium sized enterprises,subsequentlycreating more employment opportunities, more investment and of course ,locals. For the social aspects, cross –border exchanging of cultures were recognized. However As the economy along the border grows, there are also problem that come along with it as well, and obstacle the said problems tend to be chronic disease brought about by immigrants, increasing number of forest encrachment ,lack of social capital,political vulnerability, differences on how they view economic development and in a dequate infrastructure. To solve the issues, national committee could be set up opening up more cross – border checkpoints to accommodate new influx, co-invest with neighboring countries.

For traders to pursue investment opportunities the study suggested that bilaterac talk to self trade issues and implementation of intraregion payment system are strongly insisted. More over encouragement on more private investment ,implementation of contingency plans for affected entrepreneurs and farmers , employing capable workforce to effectively deal with business, monitoring trade policy improvement of quality of thai products improving production technology as well as developing better skills for labor all are needed for long term sustainability.
