

Sasithorn Jarusombuti 2014: Homeschooling Management by Career Education Concept. Doctor of Philosophy (Vocational Education), Major Field: Vocational Education, Department of Vocational Education. Thesis Advisor: Associate Professor Varataya Thamakittipop, Ph.D. 300 pages..

Since career is important to everyone thus the career education management is also important. The objectives of this research are to survey the education management for family career selection in Thailand and to develop the guideline for education for profession by family. The survey on career educational process performed by parents and caretakers was carried out. The subjects were 35 families and 19 officials from the office of area education. The data were collected by questionnaire and interviewing forms. Data were analyzed by frequency, percentage, content analysis, result synthesis and a booklet development on career educational process. The quality of the booklet was evaluated by expertise in career education using a questionnaire.

The result of this research found that 1) parents and government officials of area education lack of knowledge and understanding about career education management. So parents manage education inappropriate the age range. Parents and government officials of area education want guideline and booklet of career education that practical application, and 2) guideline of career education for homeschooling include learning plan about the purpose of learning, preparation of contents, preparation of learning and learning process evaluation in order to create awareness in the profession, personal and professional surveying and the preparation and decision-making career choices. Research results are related to different levels of education, especially basic education. Training should provide the knowledge of career education to government officials who responsible for education. Publishing this booklet to prepare for career guidance and education to various ages students.
