The objective of this research is to study the food sanitation condition of schools under the Office of Vocational Educational Commission in Mueang District, Surin Province. The collection of data is done through Canteen Survey Form (SSFS.7) and Questionaire, Obseravtion of Food Vendors, Study on Coliform contamination in food, hand contact to food and kitchen utensils- food equipment by using preliminary Coliform Test Kit (SI-2) from Department of Health. Base on the result of the study, all food shops failed to pass the standard criteria. The most standard criteria that all the food shops did not comply was cleanliness and tidiness (100%), using garbage bins without proper covers (100%). On biological aspect, Coliform contamination was found (40.64%) and it was mostly found in foods (53.33%), followed by hands contact to food (40%) and kitchen utensils-food equipments (19.75%). Therefore, these educational institutions must have proper improvement on food sanitation in compliance with food sanitation and must be monitored their food sanitation on a continual basis.
