

Duangkamol Boonwatsananant, Acting Second Lieutenant 2014: The Status of Physical Education Learning and Teaching in Primary Schools Office of the Private Education in Bangkok Metropolitan. Master of Arts (Physical Education), Major Field: Physical Education, Department of Physical Education. Thesis Advisor: Mrs. Juthamas Singhnara, Ph.D. 147 pages.

This research aims to study the status of Physical Education learning and teaching in primary schools office of the private education In Bangkok Metropolitan. The main focus is on physical education. Hence, it is a part of the private sector in Bangkok. There were 6 factors to be studied, which were instructor-lead in physical education, physical education content, program and scheduling in physical educational management, facilities and tooling, and evaluative studies. Therefore, the evaluation was done through 336 samples with the revised survey to find the quality tools. This process has been reviewed by 9 experts to make sure the data is valid (content validity). As a result, the IOC was between 0.5–1.0 and the reliability was at 0.97 The survey forms were distributed by mailing them to all samples of 336 private primary schools. All 336 samples were completed without an error, and all the samples were calculated to be 100 % valid. Data were analyzed by using percentage, and mode.

The research revealed the results as following: There were qualified instructors for physical education by taught for 16-20 hours a week. The committees were implemented their own physical education content in terms of teaching hours. The primary schools managed to teach physical education for disable students with the annual sport activities. The physical education instructors taught for 2 hours a week and some schools the time was increased by 1 hour. The safety and hygienic of all facilities and tooling were well organized and focused on users-oriented. Grades in Physical Education were based on cognitive, phycomotor, attitude. physical fitness and good characters aspect for 20, 40 20, 20, and 20 points, respectively.
