


TITLE	The Parents' Attittudes Towards Private Vocational School, In The Bangkok Technical Nonth College
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The research on "The Parents' Attitudes Towards Private Vocational School in the Bangkok Technical Nonth College" is a social research about the parents' attitudes. The research aims to assess their attitudes how they feel to the school performance. The researcher is limited to study the parents' attitudes towards the Bangkok Technical Nonth College. The researcher needs to evaluates the performance and to improve the school programs. The population of this study was about 200 persons. The assumption was that "The need of the labor market is directly relevant to the need of the parents. The school well known and the background of that school would motivate the parents to make decision to support their sons or/and daughters. So the researcher used and sent the questionnaires to those population. When they returned, the researcher worked out by statistic method including data collection, tabulation, analysis and computation by percentage and chi-squares.

The result of the study concluded that the findings were directly relevant to the assumption. The results showed that the parents' attitudes were very high to the chance of finding and getting job after the gradution and were significant to the school well known and background of those academic programs and students behavior.

From the result of the research, it can be concluded that most of the parents send their children to private vocational school because of the belief that:-

- (1) Their children will be able to get jobs as soon as they have finished the course.
- (2) The school reputation encourages their children's thoughts and ambitions.
- (3) Their children can more experience from fieldwork and supplementary activities.

The researcher suggested that although the school has been offering good services to students, some improvements should be taken to consideration:

- (1) The school should let its students and instructors know about administration policy so that they can act properly
- (2) The instructors should give more attention and close relation to their students.
- (3) School regulations should be disciplinary
- (4) The teaching aids should be regularly used in the classroom.
- (5) The school should give students the opportunities to participate in course of supplementary activities and educational exhibitions. This is to provide wider experience and to encourage students to show their own ideas.

For any research in the future, in order to obtain more useful ideas, the researcher suggest that the views and attitudes of students and instructors should be investigated.
