

A CONSTRUCTION OF HEALTH CARE SERVICE CRITERIA IN
KINDERGARTEN SCHOOL

AN ABSTRACT
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The objective of this study was to construct a health care service criteria through the Delphi Technique. The experts selected for giving responses according to this research method included 7 school administrators, 7 preschool teachers and 7 school health nurses.

The instrument used for collecting data was the five-point rating scale questionnaires of 5 factors of school health service criteria, constructed by the researcher. The questionnaires were sent out to the experts for their responses and three rounds of questionnaires were used to obtain the consensus of the majority respondents.

The final consensus were analysed by judging from the interquartile range of not more than 2.0 and the median above 2.50. There the conclusion criteria were check up for possible practice by 5 expertises.

The results revealed that :

1. Health screening including physical and mental examination, weight and hight measurement, visual screening, hearing test and health profile had 16 items.
2. Nutrient promotion including food services, eating behaviors, food and water testing, kitchen equipment, cafeteria and kitchen conditions and cook qualification had 28 items.
3. Prevention and control of diseases including seeking children with suspected communicable diseases, isolation of children with symptoms of communicable diseases, immunization and quaranties procedure had 10 items.
4. First - aid provisions including taking care of sick children, nursing station, the teacher on duty or school nurse and first - aid training had 11 items.
5. Safety including training of disaster, safety in and out school building had 18 items.
