


ตราสัญลักษณ์คุ้มครองทรัพย์สินทางวัฒนธรรมแบบทั่วไป



Emblem for the protection of cultural property (Article 16, para.1)

The Hague Convention for the Protection of Cultural Property in the Event of Armed Conflict of 14 May 1954 prescribes a blue and white shield for the identification of such property. This blue and white shield displayed on any cultural property – museum, monument, building, archaeological site and so on – means that it is prohibited to use such property for the military purposes.

To be visible from afar, the emblem must be extremely large. Its effectiveness is limited by conditions of visibility.
