ตราสัญลักษณ์คุ้มครองทรัพย์สินทางวัฒนธรรมแบบพิเศษ

Emblem for the special protection of cultural property (Article 16, para.2)

According to the Hague Convention of 14 May 1954, the transport of cultural property and cultural property of great significance shall receive special protection, marked by a group of three blue and white shields arranged in the shape of a shield. The triple emblem of protection for cultural property signifies that it is prohibited to use this property for military ends and that it must be specially protected.

Special protection is only granted if the property in question is registered in the International Register provided for this purpose. Transports under special protection are subject to international control.
