ABSTRACT

The objectives of this research were to find the level of managerial skills of the north eastern private vocational schools managers namely, conceptual skills, human skills and technical skills. Opinions of 39 headmasters and 141 assistant headmasters, totaling 180 school administrators of 39 northeastern vocational schools had been studied and compared, classified by their postions and experience. The research findings were as follows.

- 1. As a whole managerial skills of northeastern private vocational schools managers from the opinions of headmasters and assistant headmasters were at medium level. By the human skills were at high level the conceptual skills and the technical skills were at medium level.
- 2. Opinions on all the three management skills of headmasters and assistant headmasters of the northeastern private vocational schools according to their positions showed that the skills of headmasters were high and those of assistant headmasters were medium.
- 3. Opinions on all the three management skills of headmasters and assistant headmasters of private vocational schools in the northeast according to their experience holding the position for less than 5 years and more than 5 years showed that the skills of headmasters and assistant headmasters holding the position less than 5 years were high, those holding the position more than 5 years were medium.

The research findings would be used as guidelines to develop managerial skills of administrators of private vocational schools in order to enhance efficiency of vocational education administration.
