ABSTRACT

The purposes of this research were to study and to compare the opinions of those who formulated policy and plan, with practitioner on the problems of annual operation planning of technical colleges in Educational Region 6 and 12. The study concentrated on 5 steps of planning process: designing, communicating, adjusting, implementing, and monitoring. The total number of 396 person were undertaken in this study. Statistics analysis included percentage, arithmetic mean, Standard Deviation and the programmed computer SPSS/PC⁺.

Findings

- 1. The opinions of those who formulated policy and plan, and practitioner on problems of annual operation plan were at medium level in very aspect.
- 2. When the opinions of those two groups were compared, it was found that the opinions were ranked at medium level, and their opinions were not significant differences.
- 3. When the opinions of those two group classified by types of collages with only industrial programe and with other programes, it was also found that the opinions were ranked at medium level and their opinions were not significant differences.
