ABSTRACT

This research objective was to study the Educational Supervision Needed by Private Vocational School Teachers Educational Region IX.

To study the Private Vocational School Teacher's requirements for supervision in the Private Education office, Region 9. To compare the requirements of supervision of the teachers, classify by subjects and size of schools. The research studied involved a sample group of 394 Vocational Private School Teachers, from Region 9. The sample was taken during the first semester 1998. Data gathered was analyzed using statistical formulas of percentage, mean, standard deviation, t-test and F-test.

Results:

The study included as evaluation of Teaching; Equipment availability and arrangement; Techniques of teaching; Curriculum development; Teachers' Training; School and Enterprise relationship and Facilities. Analysis showed that a mean of most to least indicated. That all above were high requirement.
