The purpose of this survey research was to measure knowledge levels and to assess the legal concept of gross negligence in medical malpractice in the law of tort, government officers Act. BE 2539. The population of the study consisted of 59 lawyers working at the Ministry of Public Health. Data collection was conducted by interviewing. Statistics used in the study were percentage, mean, standard deviation and chi-square.

Results of this study showed that lawyers knowledge was good at (40.7%). There were significant relationships between knowledge of legal concepts and sex, marital status, age and experience of the lawyers ($p < 0.05$).

Based on the results of this research, it is recommended that the health directors develop their knowledge through training and improve legal concepts knowledge of the lawyers on gross negligence and medical malpractice in the law of tort.
