The purpose of this research was to study the attitudes among the athletes, the team managers and the competition committees on models and management of badminton competition for the University Games of Thailand. The instrumental questionnaires were used and presented by the statistics as follows : frequency, Mean and Standard Deviation to describe general data : and t – test comparison to analyze the significant statistic differentiation.

The results of the study were as follows :

1. The attitudes among the athletes, the team managers, and the competition committees were more compatible with the Pattern development and the Competition management of the badminton game in University Games of Thailand. Except for the activities to support the competition by describing, discussing, and skill assessing, the attitudes among them appeared in middling.

2. For the attitudes of the Competition management, it was revealed that the criteria on Court, equipment, facilities, and management in special activities were differential by the statistical significance at 0.05.
