

Research Title Attitudes of Students in Mathayomsuksa 6 in
the North Towards Chiang Mai University

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Abstract

This survey research was conducted by a random sampling method, collecting data by mailed questionnaires and interview 1787 high school students from the Mathayomsuksa 6 level in 17 provinces in the north.

The results showed that the most popular university faculty amongst the science plan students was the Faculty of Engineering while the most popular amongst the arts students was the Faculty of Humanities.

The majority of the students questioned considered that "good" and "excellent" academic attitudes and knowledge were most prominent in the Faculty of Medicine followed by the Faculty of Engineering. Other attitudes that received either "good" or "excellent" ratings were : general impression of Chiang Mai University, 95.4% ; dissemination of academic knowledge, 85.8% ;

help and support in social development, 82.1% ; conservation of local cultural traditions and customs, 81.7% ; impression of Chiang Mai University students, 80.9% ; honesty and integrity of the Chiang Mai University community as a whole, 74.7% ; and political activity, 52.5% .

Of additional note was the fact that the high school students from amphurs (districts) outside Amphur Muang gave higher "good" plus "excellent" ratings in all attitude categories than the students in Amphur Muang.
