Abstract

The Purpose of this study is to compare productivity of workers in two different shifts of metal industry as perceived by supervisors and technicians. Samples are 120 supervisors and technicians working in factories with 100-299 workers in Bangkok and its surroundings in B.E. 2535. Data are collected by questionnaires and analysed by descriptive statistics and t-test.

The finding is that work performance concerning quality of production in terms of manpower, machines, environment and products of normal shift and special shift workers is statistically significant difference at $p < 0.05$.
