Abstract

Vocational education is one of key factors in human resources development for business and industry of a country. Private sector has contributed partly in this to cope with continuous industrial growth and rapid technological change. This study aims to find opinions of experts concerning role of private vocational education for the next decade in terms of management, curriculum, standards and financial sources.

Delphi technique is used for this study. Twenty experts comprised of 8 academic scholars, 8 private education administrators and 4 from private enterprised. Data are collected by means of interview and questionnaires, and analysed in mode, median and interquartile range.

The findings are that the most important roles in management are offering program which could promote entrepreneurship development, promoting instead of controlling, providing flexible autonomous administration, recognizing the importance of information technology and customers. For curriculum the important roles are being able to set minimum occupational standard, establishing quality assurance system, having freedom to develop and implement program. For standards, the important role is establishing professional experience in order to reach the international standard. For financial sources, the important roles are establishing public revolving fund and credits, including freedom to set educational fees of their own.
