Abstract

The objective of this study is to investigate the diploma graduates in Building Construction for their performance according to employers' opinion. Samples are 133 graduates of academic years B.E. 2529-2535 working in six large construction companies in Bangkok and its surrounding. Data are collected by means of questionnaires and then analysed in percentages, arithemetic means and standard deviation.

The findings are: (a) Knowledge and skills used in field work rated high are safety precaution, building survey, concrete work and sanitary system; rated moderate are building operation, testing of building materials and machines; rated low is building accessories. (b) Knowledge and skills used in construction site office rated moderate are building cost estimation, construction planning and drawing, and computer usage; rated low is the calculation of building structure.
