## Abstract The purposes of this research are to investigate the status and job

satisfaction of industrial instructors, and to compare the satisfaction

among these instructors who have different degrees, years of work, salary

rate, and teaching class levels. The subjects from whom the data were collected were 524 industrial instructors working at nine different campuses of Rajamangala Institute of Technology. The research information was analysed by using percentage, mean, standard deviation, t - test and ANOVA.

The findings were that the job satisfaction was in average rate, for all 10 aspects, according to the general condition of most industrial instructors between 31-40 years old, with bachelor's degree, of salary from 5,001-10,000 baht, teaching students at certificate and diploma levels. After analysing each aspect, it was found that these instructors felt most

satisfied with their performance while they expressed least satisfaction

at the salary obtained. The result of the comparison was that there was

no difference in job satisfaction among instructors with different degrees

and ages. However, the job satisfaction of these who received different

rates of pay and taught at different class levels differed.
