## Abstract

Finifer classified by elements of political alienation into four elements is powerlessness, meaninglessness, normlessness and isolate. The test sample population aged 18 years and over. Residents in Bangkok, which is derived from the multi-stage sampling.

The size of the sample from a population-based sample of a sizing Yamane at 95% confidence level with a population of 5 million or more. The samples must be at least 400 people, however, researchers have determined the sample size in this study of 520 people and get back A complete data set of 441 percent, 84.04% of all queries are dealt findings are as follows...
