Surapong Plangratsamee: Expected Qualification of the Industrial Division Head in Technical College under the Department of Vocational Education. Thesis Advisors:

In technical education institutions especially the area of industrial technology, the Head of Division seems to be the key person as immediate supervisor to the staff on both administrative and academic roles. Therefore, the operation function is mainly assigned to the Division Head who was appointed by the Director with no terms of services. According to the guidelines set up by the Department of Vocational Education in 1967, the qualifications of the Division Head are as follow: diploma holder, senior staff experienced and capable person. Since then, such guidelines have not been revised. This study was to Survey the opinions of the 20 qualified experts toward the expected qualifications the Division Head should earn in order to do the work effectively in terms of the knowledge, the technical skill, and the perceptual skill by using Delphi Technique.

As the results, the experts agreed that the desired qualification of the Industrial Division Head were as follow: at least Bachelor degree holder in the responsible industrial area with experiences in teaching Technical subjects, able to set up and manage the operational program, able to transfer technical know-how, having good human relations skills with logical thinking ability including good health and appropriate manners, good time-management and having no record of financial problem.
