

The study were to examine the attitude toward Ministry of Interiors' social order policy of Sri Thana Commercial and Technological School, Chiang Mai Province and to compare the attitude by gender and experience of entering the entertaining place. The 322 subject-sample was drawn from the population of the School's students. Osgood semantic differential scale whose reliability basing Cronbach Alpha coefficient was .94 was used to gather the attitude. Statistics used included frequency, percentage, mean, standard deviation, and t-test.

It was found that in general students had good level of attitude toward social order policy. They had good attitude toward the detailed policy of prohibiting drugs in the entertaining place. Regarding the zoning, prohibition of sex show and prohibition of under 20 years old persons to enter the entertaining place, they had quite good attitude level for all the aspects.

Comparing the attitude by gender, there was no difference found. Those with experience of entering the place, however, had different attitude toward the policy of prohibiting under-aged persons in the place.
