

Abstract

A Thesis entitled "Mobilizing Resources for Students' Activities of Thammasat University" aims to study the type of resources, problems faced and the resources method seeking to conduct the activities by students of Thammasat University. The samples are 2002 the members students of the T.U. club. The data were collected and analyzed by statistical method using Percentage, Mean, Standard Deviation, t-test, F-test with significance level at 0.05.

The findings were :- Most of sampling were female, they belong to the T.U. club, aged between 20-21 years, 3rd year students. Most of them mentioned that they utilized social capital for doing the activities and that is done through co-operation of their friends which is at the highest level. They also utilized the money, budget, personnel, other available social services avail for doing the activities. However they found that they could utilize money, the personnel, the other social services equally in doing the activities and material equipment is used for the activities ,all of these are at the lowest level. As for the problem is concerned, it was found out that money was the major problem.

The study recommended that the resources mobilizing for students to organize their activities should be encouraged. The Co-ordinating systems between the students and other concerned agencies should be developed and make it move faster. There should be public relation to support students' activities in the University. There should be assessment on resources to be used for students activities regularly. Next research also should focus on the assessment of the resource mobilizing for students activities so that the proper students activities should be well planned and organized in the future.
