Abstract

This study investigated the attitude of bureaucrats in Eastern provinces towards population changes in Eastern Seaboard Industrial Estate Development Project areas and their solutions to those problems. The subjects were 169 heads of official sections in both provincial and district levels in Chonburi, Rayong and Chacheangsao province. Data were obtained by one set of questionnaire.

Results

It was found that most subjects were well aware of the population changes. According to them, the problems would be found in this areas were lack of labour force (unskilled and skilled labour, low quality labour) income problem (high cost of living, low income) slums, social problem (traffic jams,

crime, family problems, sexual mistakes, change of people morals, attitudes and values) inadequate infrastructure water supply, electricity and telephone services) medical and health (inadequate number of hospital/medical, instruments and equipments, sickness caused by industrial factories, contagious diseases came with immigrants and environment problems (water pollution, air pollution, dangerous smell of gas and chemical soil pollution, noise pollution, ineffective methods of getting rid of rubbish, and lack of cooperation among people in huping clean)

The subjects suggested that there should be the cooperative between govermental and private sectors in the following activities : increased population's income, expanded services, controlled industrial factories, increased the number of police, motivated people and factory owers to be aware of the criminal protection and environmental conservation, persuaded them to cooperate with each other in dealing with such matters, developed appropriate moral principles and towards publicity, and the community leaders should act as models.
