#### ABSTRACT

Nursing council is the authorized organization which is responsible for regulation of nursing and midwifery profession practice, including issuance of licences and enforcement of rules of professional conduct, which nurses must perceived and participated with its function . Thus, the purpose of this research was to study the relationship between selected factors and perception of role and activities of Nursing Council.

The sample was composed of 342 profession nurses from Provincial Health Office, Regional Hospital, General Hospital and Community Hospital of Ministry of Public Health in North-Eastern region of Thailand. The researcher developed for sets of questionnaires which focused on personal data, seleted factors, attitude to Nursing Council activites and perception of roles and

activities of Nursing Council. The data were analyzed by using the SPSS\* program. The statistics included : frequencies, percentage arithmetic mean, standard deviation, t-test, One-way Analysis of Variance Chi-Square, Pearson's Product Moment Correlation, and Stepwise Multiple Regression Analysis.

The results were found that the North-Eastern profession nurses' perception of role and activities of Nursing Council levels were at the middle and low levels. There was statistically significant differences in place, experience and attitude. There was a significant correlation between place, experience, attitude Nursing Council's factor and perception of role and activities of Nursing Council. The results of the Stepwise Multiple Regression Analysis showed that 12.16 percent of the variance. Attitudes and experiences were counted for two significant factors.

From this study, providing information and promote Nursing Council members to participate with Nursing Council activities continues. Then study another factors that affect Nursing council perception. Study Nursing Council's role and activities in other side. Study useful of activities that management by Nursing Council in members. Study Nursing Council's form and structure and study attitude of person who settle Nursing Council or past and present committee of Nursing Council.
