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ABSTRACT

The aim of this research was to compare the expectations of students at Diploma of Vocational Education and Diploma of Technician Education level. The respondents' expectation varied according to education background, occupation, spouse selection, age at marriage, age of mother at first child, birth timing of delivery, family size, and family relationships. The questionnaire was employed to collect information from 324 of sample size. Percentage and two - way analysis of variance were used for data analysis. The findings were as follows :

1. The expectation levels about family life of students of both groups were not different. Most of their expectation were at "good" level.

2. The expectations about age of mother at the first child was significantly different at 0.05 level according to domicile (birth place). The students' expectations about this matter in up-country were lower than students' expectation in Bangkok.

3. The students' expectations about family life were not significantly different at 0.05 level according to educational background, occupation, spouse selection, age of marriage, birth timing of delivery, family size and family relationships.

The recommendation for the next study about family life should be focused on students in up-country because the results will be badly beneficial for the development of curriculum in Population Education.
