ABSTRACT

The objectives of this study are to obtain the awareness of Crime Prevention of people in Bangkok Metropolitan residential areas, and, other factors which may affect such awareness.

The scope of this study is to gain from the samples reside in government operated community and those reside in privately operated communities. The total number of sample is 362, 119 from large size communities, 125 from middle size and 118 from small size. The data are collected through questionnaires. The results of the study can be summarized as follows :

1. The awareness of crime prevention of residents in large size communities (300 families and up) differs from that of residents in the rest. Nevertheless, the awareness of crime prevention of residents in middle size communities and that of residents in small ones do not differ.

2. The awareness of crime prevention of residents in all communities is classified in priority as the following :

2.1 Planning of environmental surroundings of the community for crime prevention

2.2 Knowledge and understanding of residents in crime prevention

2.3 Method of crime prevention of communities

2.4 Method of crime prevention of families

2.5 Participation in public activities concerning crime

2.6 Co-operation with the police

3. The difference of sexes, ages, educational levels, occupations, marital stati, family incomes, numbers of members in the families, and, the residents' and family members' prior victimization crime creates different awareness for crime prevention.
