

Abstract

The results of the study revealed that :

1. The effectiveness of health volunteer's performance was at the medium level.

2. The health volunteer with different sex, age, marital status, and income expressed similar effectiveness while health volunteer with secondary education showed higher effectiveness than those with primary education, statistically significant at the level of .05.

3. The health volunteer who had other position in the village showed higher effectiveness than those who had not, statistically significant at the level of .05. The health volunteer who had been trained and supervised monthly, and had received health information daily showed higher effectiveness than those who had not, statistically significant at the level of .05 while the health volunteer who was selected by different methods showed similar effectiveness.
