Daily life activities, and some demographic variables such as marital status, education level, income, family relationships and health status were significantly correlated with satisfaction with life. In addition, satisfaction with life was accounted for health status, daily - life activities and family relationships with variance, opproximately 61 percent And the relationship between daily - life activities, and demographic factors except sex were statistical shown.

This study indicate that for health of aging each organization should be strenghtened in promotion of health care, daily - life activities and social participation among aging.
