The objectives of the study are to find the problems and obstacles in war weapons suppression and the factors which affect such problems and obstacles. The data were collected from 200 officers in the western border patrol police task force. The results of the study are summarized as follows:

- 1. The officers who are aged not more than 25 years have highest problems and obstacles. The ones age 46 years or more, age 36 to 45 years, and age 26 to 35 years have fewer problems and obstacles respectively.
- 2. The officers who have high problems in keeping of the weapons seized have high problems and obstacles in war weapons suppression.
- 3. The officers who have high and moderate problems in coordination among the concerning units, the interruption of the influent persons, cooperation among concerning units and the dealing with the people who use the explosive mass in commercialized aspects have high problems and obstacles in war weapons suppression.
